Design Technology

Get creative in the kitchen and bake something with a hidden surprise!

8 POINTS

Science

Have fun creating your own explosion with bicarbonate of soda and vinegar. You could mix them in a cup, make a volcano, a cauldron... you decide! Don't forget to add some food dye for added excitement too. Afterwards, do some research to find out what is happening to create the explosion and write up your explanation – you'll need this to earn your team points.

10 POINTS

Any subject!

Choose another Shakespearean play and create an exciting homework that relates to it.

5 POINTS

Values and Be the best you can be!

We all have a responsibility to care for our planet. Show your recognition of this by upcycling an old jam jar into a beautiful lantern inspired by your hopes and dreams.

5 POINTS

Physical Education

Choreograph a dance 'Explosions, Potions and Dreams'. Either film your dance or do a live performance in the classroom. This is a good opportunity to share a homework task with a friend.

7 POINTS

Music

Create a piece of music to accompany your fantasy dream.

6 POINTS

Art and Design

Be inspired by nature. Collect lots of interesting natural items on a walk and then use these to create a dream catcher.

7 POINTS

Maths

Create your own 'Eye-popping Potion Drink' using any edible ingredients you wish, but make sure you're prepared to taste it! Write up your recipe carefully, ensuring that it would make enough for 6 people.

10 POINTS

Religious Education

Jesus dreamed of a better world. Write down ten things people could do to make the world a better place.

5 POINTS

History and English

Research the fascinating life of William Shakespeare and then adapt this into a comic book.

8 POINTS

English

Free writing – tell us the story of your fantasy dream.

7 POINTS

These tasks are to be completed in addition to those listed in this term's newsletter. The children will also be completing 'Hit the Button' in class (Year 5 has 12 x table and Year 6 has mixed times tables).
