

<p><b>Literacy</b> In English this term we will be encompassing part of our Roman topic, and looking at the Romulus and Remus story as a folktale from another culture. We will be looking at what makes a good folk story and writing our own, based on the Romulus and Remus story. We will also be learning how we can use adverbs and fronted adverbials in our writing to make it even better. We will be working on our handwriting and presentation skills, and will start looking for children working towards a pen licence.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b> This term we will be learning to read and use Roman numerals and extending our knowledge of place value. We will be counting in 25's 50's, 100's and 1000's, representing numbers up to 10,000 as well as finding 1, 10, 100 or 1000 more or less than any given number. We will be working on our times tables with a particular focus on 3, 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9s and using these to solve division and multiplication problems. 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**Personal, Social and Emotional Development/ French**  
Mrs Delrosa will be PSHE and French in Class 3.  
We will be looking at resilience and how we can support others as well as building our own resilience.  
The children will be learning basic French vocabulary including numbers and greetings.

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**RE**  
This term in RE we will be asking ourselves the question "What do Christians learn from the creation story?" We shall be exploring Genesis in the old testament and looking into Christian's beliefs.  
We will be exploring the core Christian value of truthfulness through our whole school and class worship.

**PE**  
This term is gymnastics.  
We will be exploring different ways of travelling through floor work and using apparatus whilst developing our balance and coordination skills.  
We will combine movements into a routine which we will share with others; supporting our peers to achieve their best.

**Science**  
This term is full of very practical and fun filled science lessons as we look at forces/magnets and materials. We have a letter from P&P Toys who need us to test materials and forces for new toys. We will be scientifically investigating and recording our results clearly to report back. In our lessons we will be comparing how things move on different surfaces, creating fair tests and recording results, investigating friction, force, push and pull forces, magnetics and making predictions.

**History/ Geography**  
This is a fantastic topic which the children have already shown a great interest in. This term we will be investigating the history of the Roman Empire and how it grew to its peak and why it eventually declined. We shall be using atlases to help us identify where the Romans invaded and the internet to research their Gods, beliefs and inventions.  
We will look at Boudica's rebellion and use this to create newspapers and other non-fiction pieces of writing.
