

Behaviour

We have high expectations from every pupil at our School and expect them to show respect for the School Code of Behaviour; an official document which is written by the pupils at the start of each year. For actions which support this code, children are rewarded with verbal praise, certificates in assembly and extra 'Golden Time Minutes' at the end of the week. For children who choose to ignore the Code, appropriate sanctions are put in place. A copy of these Sanctions can be found in the School Behavioural Policy, which can be obtained on request.

This Year's Code of Behaviour

1. Respect all property in school.
2. Always tell the truth.
3. Use polite languages at all times.
4. Treat people as you wish to be treated.
5. Listen when other people are speaking.
6. Respect everyone and everything.
7. Respect other people's right for privacy.
8. Be friendly to each other, care and be kind.
9. Cooperate in the classroom and on the playground.
10. Be patient when asking or answering questions.

In each class, there is a Rights Respecting Charter which every child is familiar with and played a part in creating. Each charter provides guidance for children, underlining our collective expectation of good behaviour at all times. We also have a Home/School contract, which should be upheld by all concerned.
