

# Transfer Procedure

We aim to provide every year six pupil with the skills, knowledge and confidence to continue their learning journey as they move on to their secondary schools. Parents will receive the relevant information about secondary choices at the start of year six and our Head Teacher and Deputy Head are always available to discuss any anxieties or questions which you or your child may have.

The majority of our children transfer to Rednock School in Dursley with whom we have very strong links. Our pupils are already familiar with members of the Rednock staff team who host local sporting events for the primary schools. As well as Rednock, we also have a number of pupils who opt for Grammar Schools, including Stroud High School for Girls and Marling School for Boys in Stroud. Entry to these schools is via an examination and parents need to apply directly. A small number also transfer to Katherine Lady Berkeley School in Wotton-under-Edge and Sir William Romney School in Tetbury.

On request from your chosen school, the Year 6 teacher responsible for your child will work closely to provide detailed information on your child's current achievements and abilities to ensure that the transition is as smooth as possible, enabling your child to be continually challenged. Parents and pupils are invited to attend an Information Evening and Taster Day during the Summer term, a great opportunity for the children to get an early secondary experience.
