We would really appreciate your co-operation. We do charge a £5 late fee and if it becomes a regular occurrence then you may forfeit your child's place at Fun Club.

Please can we request that parents and children do not go down the corridor during a Fun Club pick up. If a child has forgotten any items they must be picked up the following day. The children are aware of this and staff do remind them to pick up all items from the classroom at the end of the school day.
