








## Class 3- Spring Term Homework

As part of our new topic 'Inside Out' we have created a collection of homework tasks below for you to choose from. Children must complete a **minimum of 4 tasks**. Completed tasks can be brought into school anytime between now and **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March** and will be carefully shared and looked after. All of the children will have the opportunity to share their homework and have it on display in the classroom. Each task has an assigned number of team points that they can earn- how many can they collect?

 <p>Write your own play about the time a volcano erupted! (maybe look at Pompeii)</p> <p><b>5 team points</b></p>	 <p>We are going to look at different inventors. Choose an historical inventor and find out what you can about their work. Show this in any way you like (poster/book/leaflets/make a game...)</p> <p><b>10 team points</b></p>	 <p>Listen to a piece of music and paint/ draw a picture showing how it makes you feel.</p> <p><b>5 team points</b></p>	 <p>Be an inventor of sport! Can you create your own sport or game? Include: how to play it, the rules of the game, what you wear and where it is played.</p> <p><b>10 team points</b></p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Should all hunting be banned? Should Britain stay in the EU?</b></p> <p>This term so far the class have tried to think of balanced arguments for controversial topics. Choose a question/topic and write your arguments for and against it. This can be tricky, so remember to look at both sides possible opinions.</p> <p><b>10 team points</b></p>
 <p>Write a diary entry as if you were a famous inventor or character from your favourite book.</p> <p><b>10 team points</b></p>	<p><b>Inside Out</b></p>  <p>They are like trees that grow beside a stream that bear fruit at the right time and whose leaves do not dry up.
