Literacy

We will continue to develop our knowledge of Phonics this term with children working with a range of phase 3 and phase 5 phonic sounds, depending on which group they are in. Children will also continue to learn a range of high frequency and tricky words. For more information on this please ask.

We will also be reading a selection of fictional stories that link with our topic such as 'Where The Wild Things Are' and 'Funnybones'. Our nonfiction work will include labelling and caption writing and we will also be reading some poetry linked to the 5 senses.
