They build on their learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food, water, air and shelter. </p> <p>In the Pull and Push project your child will learn about three types of mechanism: sliders, levers and linkages. They make models of each mechanism before designing and making a greetings card with a moving part</p>	<p>English Children will continue to receive daily phonics lessons. This will support both their reading, and spelling skills. They also learn about managing money and caring for our environment.</p>	<p>Magnificent Monarchs</p>  <p>Summer Term 2026 Year 1 & 2 Miss Spain</p>	<p>History & Geography </p> <p>The Magnificent Monarchs project teaches your child about the English and British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day. Using timelines, information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources, they build up an understanding of the monarchs and then research six of the most significant sovereigns.</p> <p>Design Technology:</p> <p>In the Cut, Stitch, and Join project your child will learn about fabric home products and the significant British brand Cath Kidston. They learn about sewing patterns and using a running stitch and embellishments before making a sewn bag tag. </p>	
<p>Physical Education </p> <p>In the Games for understanding unit your child will learn about the principles of attack and defence. Then will apply these in a game. In the Dodging unit your child will learn to explore and develop dodging skills; before applying in a game situation</p>	<p>Art & Design: </p> <p>In the Portraits and Poses project your child will learn about portraiture. They analyse the portraits of Tudor monarchs and compare Tudor portraits and selfies today. They use photo editing software to create royal portraits. </p>		
<p>Music: </p> <p>In the Friendship Song unit your child will learn about singing and playing together in an ensemble. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, child will listen and appraise other songs about friendship. This Reflect, Rewind, Replay unit consolidates your child's from the year. They will revisit songs and musical activities, building knowledge of the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music</p> <p>Computing: Information Technology </p> <p>In the Animated Story Books unit your child will learn to use a program such as 2Create-a-story.
