
Homework share this term will Monday 27th June, 2.45pm.

- Design and create a habitat for an invertebrate or vertebrate
- Make an information PowerPoint about all the different bugs in your garden/ local area.
- Tally chart- then a pictogram- how many bugs in your garden/ local area. Can you use ICT to present this?
- How far can you count in Egyptian? Record as a video!

The love of the written word

- Create your name in hieroglyphics- use different mediums to present (paint, pens, computer font)
- Write an adventure story all about your favourite bug.

 Take photographs to share


Sport and fair play
