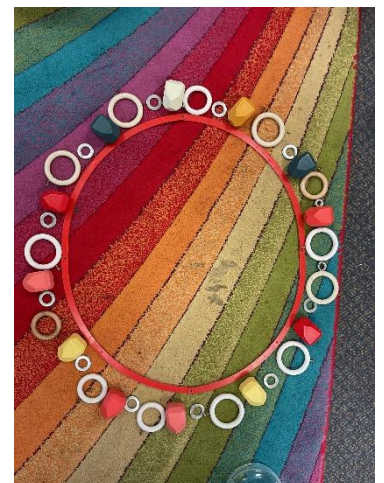
Classes 1 and 2

Class 2

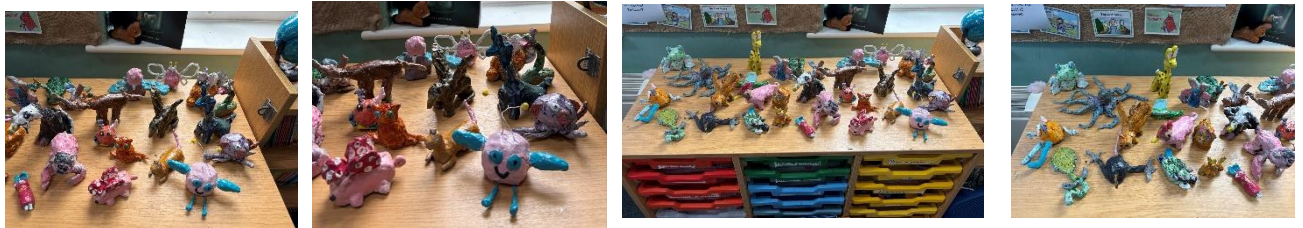
Growing and changing Helping Hands

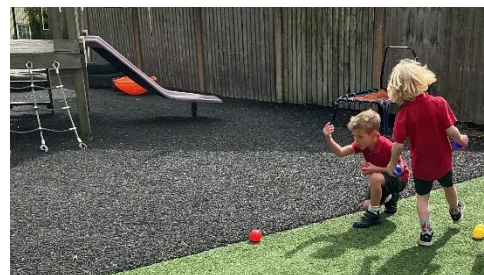
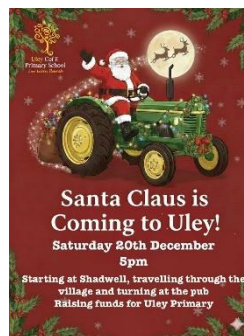


Thank You!
